NATIONAL TRUST HOSTS INAUGURAL ANNUAL HERITAGE GALA

"Such an elegant, intimate affair," is how one enthusiastic member described the National Trust Heritage Gala that was hosted by the Governor General on August 11th, on the picturesque grounds of Government House.

Guests dressed in 'heritage wear' mingled on the front lawn, sipping locally made wine and listening to the strains of string band music.

They feasted on traditionallyinspired fare, viewed special video presentations about the work of the Trust, and were entertained by the dynamic Huggins Masquerade Troupe and the Jingle Bells String Band.



An art auction later in the evening caused quite a buzz as works by local artists Joan Mallalieu, Tom Jones and Vaughn Anslyn were put on the block. The auction raised several thousand dollars toward the Trust's Heritage Appeal.

"Our Heritage Appeal gala was our way of saying thank you to the

many individuals and firms who had made a financial contribution to our Appeal Fund," Executive Director Ryllis Percival stated.



"The work of the Trust depends on the financial support of our members and we cannot do it without the funds," she said, going on to thank the members of the volunteer committee, led by Mrs. Laverne Caines who planned the event and worked hard to make the evening a success.

TRUST PRESIDENT **CALLS FOR** CHRISTENA EXHIBIT

The President of the National Trust Schneidman Warner has expressed his support for the mounting of an exhibit about the sinking of the MV Christena.

"It's a story that needs to be told and unfortunately it is not yet part of our curriculum and it's almost 50 years old," Mr. Warner remarked during a press conference at the Museum on August 1st, the anniversary of Christena disaster.

Mr. Warner acknowledged the anniversary and remarked that it was a pivotal event in the country's history.

"The sinking of the Christena on August 1st 1970 is a very important day in our history, because the over 200 people who died on that day represent the largest single loss of life on a single day in the history of this country," he said.



The MV Christena was a government-owned ferry that plied the channel between St. Kitts and Nevis for some 11 years. The vessel regularly travelled at well over its capacity of 155 passengers.

On that fateful day in 1970, the Christena went down off St. Kitts' Nag's Head on the day's final run to Nevis. There were 320 people onboard. Ninety one survived.

"I trust that one of these days the National Trust will be able to mount an exhibition of the Christena disaster and [how] it affected us." Mr. Warner stated.

While there is a monument along Charlestown's Bay Front listing the names of those who perished, a monument has never been mounted in St. Kitts to memorialize the event or those who lost their lives.
